## CFP National Championship

On Monday, January 10, 2022, #3 seed Georgia played #1 seed Alabama in the college football playoff national championship. A few minutes later, Georgia TE, Brock Bowers scored a touchdown, to give Georgia an even bigger 26-18 lead. In the last minute of the game, Georgia DB, Kelee Ringo, got a pick six. That Ended the game 33-18 Georgia!


The dog ate my homework


Once upon a time I was walking,
